MESSAGE RECAP

In this week's message, we focus on a mindset shift that can make all the difference in how we view partnering with the church. It's the idea that I think like an owner. Members have benefits, but owners have responsibilities. When I think like an owner, I understand that the buck stops with me (John 10:11-13) and I have a responsibility to the rest of the body (Ephesians 2:19-22).
