Canceling is better than commitment. We've decided to push back against indifference, apathy, or nominal Christianity. This week, we explored a parable filled with excuses (Luke 14:16-23). It's easy to make excuse but it's better to take Jesus up on the invitation. Dave said, "As soon as God invites you to something great, Satan give you an excuse to stay away." There are two great things God invites us to. An invitation to believe in Jesus and Invitation to belong to a community of likeminded people, The Church.
