- 6. We said, "When we engage our community with a gospel identity at our core, we do not retreat and run, we engage for the good of the world around us." Is your tendancy to actively work for the world around you, or in spite of it? How can you engage differently? (See <u>Jeremiah 29:5-7</u>)
