MESSAGE RECAP

Happy Easter!!!! We really hope you were able to take time to focus on the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus. This week's message is specifically focused on the gift of grace because of Jesus. This grace is for you, this grace is for me, and this grace is for our enemies. Why? Because "Uncomfortable Grace sees a bigger picture." That was never truer than Easter morning. It's true of the story we tell as we, like Paul, say: "For it is by grace you have been saved..."

GROUP DISCUSSION

- **1.** After being a part of the weekend services what stood out to you? Songs, Sermon, Baptisms, Cupcakes, Testimony Video, People who came, etc.
- **2.** Have you ever been uncomfortable with the amount of grace you've received, or others have received? Why?
- **3.** Uncomfortable Grace: "We are more sinful than we realize and more loved than we realize." Read <u>1 Corinthians 15:1-4</u>. In what ways does this become of first importance to our salvation? How has this become part of your testimony?
- **4.** Uncomfortable Grace: "Helps Doubters become believers." Read 1 Cor. 15:5-8 How important was it for Jesus to reveal himself to over 500 people? In what ways has He done the same for you?
- **5.** Uncomfortable Grace: "Grace cleans up what we mess up." Read 1 Cor. 15:9-10 Where has grace impacted your story? Where do you need to continue to pray for more grace in your life?
- **6.** We said there are two responses to grace, abuse grace or appreciate grace. Read Romans 6:1-4 and talk through the differences in your own life.
