- **5.** Jesus never accepted sin; he came to die as a sacrifice because of it. But he did accept sinners. How do we live this out ourselves?
- **6.** The good news Jesus came to bring is both inclusive and exclusive. How can it be both?
- **7.** There are 3 common ways a church perceives its mission to the world: Evade, Pervade, or Engage. How are each of those played out? Which one is more your tendency personally?
- 8. What's a practical way to live with radical acceptance of others this week?
