- **5.** Francis Schaeffer said that "Biblical orthodoxy without compassion is surely the ugliest thing in the world." Do you believe that's true?
- **6.** Read <u>Matthew 9:37-38</u>. Have you ever seen yourself & the church to be the answer to that prayer?
- **7.** Read <u>James 4:7</u>. If compassion doesn't move you to action, is it really compassion? What is it then?
- **8.** Talk about some specific ways you can show compassion to the unchurched this week.
