MESSAGE RECAP

Paul closes out the book of Colossians, emphasizing the theme of living "More on Mission." Jonathon outlined five essential ingredients for a mission-focused life, including the recognition of hardship, the role of scripture, the importance of a supportive team, the role of deeds and words, and the centrality of prayer. The message encourages every believer to embrace mission in their everyday lives, understanding that wherever their feet are is where they are on mission.

GROUP DISCUSSION

1. Read [Colossians 4:2-18](#). What are some things that stand out to you as we read this?
2. How have you experienced or witnessed hardship in your efforts to live on mission or share the message of Christ? In what ways can hardship be viewed as a natural part of living on mission, and how can it be an opportunity for growth and perseverance?
3. Discuss the significance of Paul's instruction to share the letter with the Laodiceans. How does this reflect the communal aspect of engaging with scripture?
4. Reflect on the various individuals mentioned by Paul in the passage. What role does community and teamwork play in living on mission? How can you actively engage with a team or community in your efforts to live more on mission?
5. Share examples of situations where you have seen the combination of wise actions and gracious words effectively impact others.
6. What specific prayers can you commit to for yourself and others to have open doors and clarity in proclaiming the message of Christ?
7. Share specific plans or actions you can take to be more on mission in your daily life this week.
