MESSAGE RECAP

This week's message focused on our home lives. If the gospel hasn't taken root at home, then it hasn't taken root. Ultimately, both husbands and wives are called to honor Jesus by emulating Jesus in our marriage. It's all about living out the Gospel in our everyday lives and making Jesus the center of our homes. These verses challenge us to live our lives in accordance with the Lord's design.

GROUP DISCUSSION

1. For Married:
 - a. The message emphasized the quality of your marriage matters to God. In what ways can you or are you working on your marriage to honor God?
 - b. How was your understanding of "submission" and "love" more informed because of the message?
 - c. Husbands: What are some ways you can show sacrificial love in your marriage, even when it's difficult?
 - d. Wives are called to submit out of honor and respect for Jesus. How can you strike a balance between submission and empowerment in your marriage?
 - e. Challenge: Daily Prayer Together – Talk through this and challenge one another.
2. For Singles:
 - a. The sermon highlighted the importance of living like Jesus in the example of singleness. In what ways can you emulate Jesus in your current season of life?
 - b. The concept of "submission" was discussed in the context of marriage. How do you interpret "submission" and "honor" in the context of non-marital relationships or your interactions with others? (Read Philippians 2:1-5)
 - c. If you're seeking a future relationship, how can you actively prepare yourselves to become the person God desires in a marriage?
 - d. How can you pray for one another and support one another?
