ACTS 8:26-40

MESSAGE RECAP

The Spirits leading in the early church should be true of us today. It should be true of the way we make an impact on the community around us. By looking at Philip's encounter with the Ethiopian eunuch, we find four key aspects of being led by the Spirit. Sensitivity to the prompting of the Spirit enables us to engage in meaningful, impactful gospel-centered conversations that can change the world.

GROUP DISCUSSION

1. Read [Acts 8:26-40](#) and talk through different ideas that stand out.
2. In what ways was Philip guided by the Spirit?
3. Where has the Spirit led you recently? Share an experience where you felt led by the Spirit unexpectedly or found yourself in a position to impact someone's life.
4. How do you discern Spirit's guidance in conversations about faith? Share a time when you felt prompted by the Spirit during a conversation with someone.
5. In what ways can we be more attentive to the Spirit's leading in our everyday lives, especially concerning interaction with others who need to hear about Jesus?
6. Think through the places God has you, the people, and the activities you're in. Who is the "one" the Spirit might be calling you to reach out to or connect with?
7. What are your hopes and prayers for the people you encounter in your daily life regarding their spiritual journey? How can we collectively pray for those people in our lives?
