MESSAGE RECAP

This week's Matt Cooper explored the countdown to Christmas, continuing to focus on Christophanies—pre-incarnate appearances of Christ—before Bethlehem. Using Jacob's story from Genesis 32:24-32, he highlighted Jacob's wrestling match. This struggle symbolized the challenges individuals face in their faith journeys. The message emphasized the importance of honesty before God, acknowledging past mistakes, and allowing Him to redefine one's identity. It encouraged coming to Jesus, trusting in His sacrifice, and engaging honestly with God during struggles, promising His sustaining presence. Ultimately, the message emphasized transformation, redemption, and triumph through Christ's victory, using the image of Jacob limping but victorious at sunrise.

- **5.** Matt mentioned that in our faith in Jesus, we will encounter moments where we wrestle with God. Have you ever felt like you were wrestling with God? How did you handle those moments?
- **6.** Consider the transformation of Jacob, where his name is changed to Israel. In what ways have you experienced a transformation or change in your identity through your faith journey?
