4. In what ways can we engage with Compassion International's sponsorship? How might sponsoring a child impact our home, family, or even our church?
5. What are some other ways you might be able to show compassion in our community?
6. Consider the verse from 2 Cor 1:3-4. How does God's comfort in our troubles connect with our ability to comfort others? Share instances where you've seen this principle in action or opportunities to apply it.
