## **MESSAGE RECAP**

This week's message focuses on the concept of finishing well by leaving a legacy of blessings. This is not necessarily a monetary blessing but the impact you can make on others' lives by your faith. The author of Hebrews will look at the final moments of Isaac, Jacob, and Joseph and how they finished by faith. By faith, we leave a legacy of blessings. The significance of blessing others with our faith in Jesus, our speech, character, faithfulness, wisdom, generosity, forgiveness, and hope are ways to leave a legacy.

- **2.** How does the concept of leaving a legacy resonate with you, personally? Have you ever considered what kind of legacy you want to leave behind?
- **3.** Read through Hebrews 11:20-22 and process the significance of these final moments. In what ways is the faith of Isaac, Jacob, and Joseph on display?
- **4.** In what ways have you experienced the impact of blessings in your own life, either from others or by passing them on to others? This may be difficult but try to share the blessing you experienced from others who have passed.
- **5.** Which of the seven ways to leave a legacy of blessings (faith, speech, character, faithfulness, wisdom, generosity, forgiveness) do you find most challenging?
- **6.** Read through Genesis 50:24-25 and Hebrews 11:22. Reflecting on the story of Joseph's faith in the future exodus, how can we maintain hope and share it with others amid challenges and hardships?
- **7.** What practical steps can you take to start working on your legacy of faith that blesses others?
