MESSAGE RECAP

In Matthew 6:19-24, Jesus dives into a sensitive issue of money and possessions, highlighting their temporary nature and the dangers of making them our masters. 2. Reflect on your own life: What treasures do you find yourself pursuing?
3. Security: Read Matthew 6:19-21. In what ways does money fail to provide legitimate security, and how can we find true security in God?
 - a. How can we practically store up treasures in heaven?
4. Heart Focus: Matthew 6:21. How might we discern where our heart's treasure truly lies?
5. Money and Master: Matthew 6:24. What does it mean for money to be a servant or a master in our lives?
6. Application: Share a practical way you can shift your focus from earthly treasures to heavenly ones. Matthew 6:22-23
7. How does having a heavenly perspective on money change the way we view our finances?
