## MESSAGE RECAP

This Sunday, Dave and Matt shared about the incredible week our students and invited our church into the camp theme of being set free from sin through freedom in Christ. Romans 6:11 reminds us to consider ourselves "dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus," emphasizing that Jesus' sacrifice allows us to be in close relationship with God. We learned that true freedom in Jesus changes our identity, sets our hearts free, and calls us to live differently, leaving our old chains behind and embracing a life of holiness and love. As we live a life set free, it should cause us to carry the 'key' to our spaces; sharing the Gospel of Jesus unto the world.

4. Ephesians 4:23-24 calls us to live holy lives. What practical steps can you take to "throw off your old self" and embrace your new identity in Christ?
5. How can we, as individuals and as a community, actively share the freedom we have in Jesus with those around us? What are some specific ways you can bring the message of freedom to your family, friends, or coworkers?
