MESSAGE RECAP

In the darkness and waiting, God is often preparing us for something greater. Joseph's time in prison serves as a reminder that God's timing is perfect, even when we feel overlooked or forgotten.

GROUP DISCUSSION

- 1. How do you handle situations when life feels unfair or hard, like it did for Joseph?
- 2. Read <u>Genesis 40:1-4a</u>. Joseph stayed faithful to God even in prison. How can you stay close to God when you face challenges?
- 3. How can you look for God's work in your life, even when things aren't going the way you hoped?
- **4.** Read <u>Genesis 40:14-15</u>. Why is it easier to speak up for yourself, rather than rely on God's timing?
- **5.** Read <u>Galatians 3:3</u>. It's easy to focus on the seen circumstances instead of the Spiritual. How can we shift that focus?
- 6. Read <u>2 Corinthians 4:17-18</u>. Joseph stayed faithful despite his long struggles. How does his story encourage you to keep going when life gets hard?
- 7. Can you think of a time when you felt forgotten or unseen but later saw how God was with you? How does that change how you view waiting now?
