

ON EDGE: RUNNING FROM FAILURE

MESSAGE RECAP

Failure can often feel final, but Moses' story reveals that God meets us in our worst moments and speaks truth into the lies we believe about ourselves. We can fall into the trap of believing we are the sum of our failures, that isolation will protect us, or that some things can't be forgiven. But scripture reminds us that God's truth is greater than the enemy's lies, and that transformation begins when we let God renew our minds. Our identity is not found in our past, but in the One who calls us forward.

GROUP DISCUSSION

1. After listening to the message, what stood out to you?
2. Read Exodus 2:11-15. What stands out to you about Moses' actions and motivations? Have you ever made a mistake while trying to do something right?
3. What are some lies you've believed about yourself after failure? How have/had those lies shaped your identity or decisions?
4. Moses doubted God's calling multiple times (Exodus 3:11, 4:1, 4:10, and 4:13). Why do you think God continued to pursue him? What does that say about how God sees you?
5. Read Romans 12:2. What does it practically look like to be "transformed by the renewing of your mind?" Have you experienced this in your own life?
6. What is one step you can take this week to step out of a mental rut and start moving forward in faith?
