MESSAGE RECAP

Revelation 12 pulls back the curtain to reveal the invisible war behind everything we see. This is John's "Christmas story"—but with a dragon in the nativity scene! John shows us two great signs: a woman clothed with the sun and a massive red dragon. The woman represents Israel, Mary, and the Church—all through whom God brings His Son into the world. The dragon represents Satan, the ancient serpent and accuser, who constantly seeks to lead the world astray and destroy what God loves. Believers overcome not through strength or cleverness, but "by the blood of the Lamb and the word of their testimony." We win by trusting in Jesus' finished work and boldly declaring His faithfulness in our lives. Even when life feels like a war, we remember the battle is already decided.

GROUP DISCUSSION

1. How are you...really?
2. How early is too early to start the Christmas season? (Be nice!)
3. Read Revelation 12:1–6.
 - a. How might these images help you understand God's story through Israel, Mary, and the Church?
 - b. Why do you think John connects this vision to the story of Jesus' birth?
4. Revelation 12:10 calls Satan "the accuser of our brothers and sisters."
 - a. What are some of the ways that an accusing voice can show up in your life today?
 - b. How does knowing what Christ has done silence that voice?
5. Triumph and Testimony: Read Revelation 12:11
 - a. What do those two weapons mean for you personally?
 - b. How could your story or testimony be a weapon of light against darkness?
6. Revelation 12: 17 reminds us that the dragon still wages war against those who follow Jesus.
 - a. Where do you feel that spiritual opposition most in your life or family right now?
7. Pray for each other's Spiritual battles.
