

LIGHT HAS COME (WEEK 3)

December 21st, 2025

MESSAGE RECAP

This week's message focused on Light Reflected — the truth that God not only brings light into darkness, but He intends His people to shine that light into the world. Paul tells us in Philippians that when we live without grumbling or arguing and instead follow Jesus wholeheartedly, we “shine like stars in the sky.” The message explored how the Magi were drawn to Jesus by a literal star, and how our lives are meant to serve as the same kind of guiding light today.

GROUP DISCUSSION

1. How are you...really?
2. Read Philippians 2:14–15
 - a. Where do you find yourself wrestling with grumbling, complaining, or internal debating with God?
 - b. What would it look like this week to respond differently — in a way that reflects Jesus rather than reacts to circumstances?
3. Read Matthew 2:1–2, 9–11. Just like the Magi followed a star toward Jesus, people today follow the “light” they see in others.
 - a. Where has God placed you (family, workplace, friendships, school, team) to be a guiding star for someone?
 - b. What specific actions could help someone around you take a step closer to Jesus?
4. Daniel's consistent faith shaped an entire culture's view of God — even under pressure. (Daniel 2:47–48 & Daniel 6:10)
 - a. What part of Daniel's example challenges you most: courage, prayer habits, purity, integrity, or perseverance?
 - b. What is one way you can begin reflecting that same steady light in your own rhythm this week?
5. What is one next step the Spirit might be nudging you toward to reflect Jesus more clearly?
