

ACT LIKE WOMEN: WEEK 2

MESSAGE RECAP

This week continued our Act Like Women series with a strong and encouraging challenge: women are not an afterthought in God's Kingdom — they are central to His mission. Scripture shows women as courageous, wise, resilient, and purpose-filled. God created women with strength, design, and calling, and the enemy has been attacking that identity from the beginning.

The message emphasized three key truths:

- Women have a Kingdom purpose in the world
- Women show wisdom to the world
- Women bring life into the world—physically and spiritually

GROUP DISCUSSION

1. After listening to the message, what stood out to you?
2. The sermon highlighted that women often feel pressure from the world (appearance, performance, opinions, objectification, not being heard, etc.).
 - a. What pressures do you think women feel most strongly today?
 - b. Which one do you personally feel most often?
3. Scripture — 1 Timothy 2:9–10
 - a. Paul says true “adornment” is not ultimately external—it’s a life marked by good deeds.
 - i. What do you think Paul is protecting women from in this passage?
 - ii. What do you think he is calling women into?
4. The sermon listed many women in the Bible who made a difference (Deborah, Esther, Ruth, Priscilla, Phoebe, etc.).
 - a. Which woman from Scripture inspires you most—and why?
 - b. What quality do you want to grow in your own life?
5. Read Luke 10:38–42:
 - a. Where is God calling us all to be?
 - b. What step of courage is God asking you to take—using your influence, gifting, or voice—in your family, church, or calling?
6. Pray over the women in your group by name.
