## MESSAGE RECAP

This week's message explored what true generosity looks like through the stories of Abraham, David, and ultimately Jesus on Mount Moriah. Abraham demonstrated a surrendered heart by trusting God completely and believing "The Lord will provide," even when asked to give up what mattered most. David showed that genuine worship and generosity are sacrificial, declaring, "I will not sacrifice to the Lord what costs me nothing." Ultimately, Jesus' sacrifice on the cross demonstrates a surrendered and sacrificial heart, given for each of us. True generosity flows from hearts fully surrendered to Him.

## GROUP DISCUSSION

- 1) A Generous Heart is Surrendered: Read Genesis 22:1-18 together.
  - a) Abraham repeatedly said, "The Lord will provide." What is an area of your life where you struggle to fully trust God's provision?
- 2) Why do you think generosity becomes harder when it involves something valuable, personal, or costly to us?
- 3) A Generous Heart Is Sacrificial: Read 2 Samuel 24 together.
  - a) David would not sacrifice offerings that cost him nothing. What does sacrificial worship or generosity look like in today's world?
- 4) Dave talked about moving from "attending church" to "being the church".
  - a) What are some ways your faith changes when you take ownership instead of just attending?
- 5) All We Could Ever Need: Read John 3:16-17 and Romans 6:23.
  - a) Jesus demonstrated the ultimate act of generosity through His sacrifice on the cross. How should God's generosity toward us shape the way we live, give, and serve others?
  - b) What kind of spiritual legacy do you hope to leave for the next generation?
